DOCUMENTS NEEDED TO COMPLETE YOUR APPLICATION

COPY OF PASSPORT: A copy of the biographical page of your passport and visa if available.

OFFICIAL ACADEMIC CREDENTIALS & TEST SCORES: High school diploma or transcript, SAT/ACT, TOEFL or IELTS scores.

DEMONSTRATION OF FINANCIAL RESOURCES: Submit a bank statement, certificate of balance, or sponsorship letter or any combination of the three.

TRANFER WITHIN USA: Submit official transcript from the university, a copy of your current I-20, and signed copy from new school's Student Advisor Form.

OPTIONAL PERSONAL STATEMENTS & LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION:

Reference letters, proof of achievement, certificates, etc.



INTERNATIONAL STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

PRESIDENTIAL SCHOLARSHIP: \$7.000

Criteria: SAT 1500 or 30 ACT OR VALECT OR Exemplary achievement documented by student and approved by scholarship committee such as IMO Medallion Recipient or other Remarkable Achievements

TRUSTEE SCHOLARSHIP: \$6.000

Criteria: SAT 1300 or 27 ACT OR SALECT OR outstanding achievement documented by student and approved by scholarship committee such as ISWEEP Gold/ Top 1% National Exam OR International Transfer students with 3.50 CTGPA & 60 credits

DEAN SCHOLARSHIP: \$5.000

Criteria: SAT 1100 or 24 ACT OR U.S. HS GPA 3.4 OR Remarkable achievement documented by student such as ISWEEP Silver/Bronze Recipient/Top 5% national exam OR International Transfer students with 3.0 CTGPA & 40 credits

STALLION SCHOLARSHIP: \$4,000

Criteria: SAT: SAT 1000 or 21 ACT OR U.S. HS GPA 3.2 OR Noteworthy achievement documented by student such as ISWEEP honorable participation/Top 10%National Exam OR International Transfer students with 2.50 CTGPA & 30 credits

TEXAN SCHOLARSHIP: \$2.000

Criteria: SAT 900 or 18 ACT OR U.S. HS GPA 3.0 OR Recognizable achievement documented by student such as Top 25% National Exam/Certificate of Appreciation OR International Transfer students 2.00 CTGPA & 10 credits
