North American University's 3rd Annual International Conference July 18-20, 2023

North American University (NAU) is happy to announce its 3rd Annual International Conference with the theme of ***Global Challenges and Opportunities in Higher Education*** during July 18-20, 2023 (Tuesday-Thursday) at Stafford Center (10505 Cash Rd, Stafford, TX 77477, USA) and NAU (11929 W Airport Blvd, Stafford, Texas 77477, USA). This educational conference intends to bring together a plethora of leading experts from multiple disciplines across the globe, mainly from the higher education institutions offering courses in the fields of Business Administration, Computer Science, Criminal Justice, and Education. This conference will be an excellent forum to gain insights into the challenges faced in this era of internationalization of higher education; identify innovative opportunities in the context of recent social, economic, political, and technological scenario; and broaden the academic experiences that might help augment academic programs, research, and scholarly collaboration, sharing and learning from cross-border experiences.

This three-day conference will include several presentations, scholarly discussions, and networking opportunities such as faculty mobility, international student exchanges, dual diploma programs, faculty collaborative research, and university presidents' roundtables. These efforts reflect NAU's commitment to the United Nations' Sustainable Development Goals, specifically Goal #4 - Education and Goal #17 - Partnerships, as global institutions address critical issues that affect our societies and the world.

Participants are invited to contribute their original papers for presentation during this conference related to higher education in the fields of Business Administration, Computer Science, Criminal Justice, and Education. The papers could be based on original research, surveys, case studies or action plans that are not presented or published elsewhere. It should be submitted in MS Word format in maximum 3000 words (Works Cited and Notes included in the word count). Selection of papers will be based on the abstract. An official language of this Conference is English, hence, all the abstracts, papers as well as presentations will have to be in English.

Abstract submissions must include

- Name, title, institution, and email of author(s).
- Title of proposed paper
- Abstract of a paper in Word format in 200-300 words.
- A list of 5-10 keywords of the paper
- Brief biographical statement about each author in Word format in maximum 200 words.

- Notification of acceptance of abstracts: Friday, April 7, 2023, 5pm CST
- Deadline for full paper submission: Friday, May 12, 2023, 5pm CST
- Notification of acceptance of full paper: Friday, May 26, 2023, 5pm CST
- Conference registration deadline: Friday, June 2, 2023, 5pm CST
