Submit a Proposal

The Call for Proposals is now open! The 2026 NAU AIC Planning Committee invites proposals for this upcoming conference taking place on May 7-9, 2026, at Stafford, TX, USA. The Planning Committee is interested in 15-20 minute presentation proposals centered around the conference theme. Presentation proposals should be grounded in original research, empirical studies, case analyses, or strategic action plans that have not been previously presented or published.

Remote participation will be facilitated through YouTube streaming with virtual presentations supported through Microsoft Teams. To ensure a smooth experience, all virtual presenters are required to submit a prerecorded video of their presentation to the Planning Committee in advance.

All presenters are required to register for the conference. The **registration fee is \$100** and can be paid through the Registration Form available at https://www.na.edu/international-conference/.

- Title of proposed presentation
- Brief description of proposal/abstract (up to 250 words)
- A list of 5-10 keywords
- Brief bio of the Presenter (up to 250 words). You will be contacted to provide bios of the additional presenters if your proposal is accepted.
- The official language of this Conference is English; hence, all the proposals and presentations must be in English.
