

## REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

#### GOVERNMENT-ISSUED PASSPORT

The passport must not expire before the first day of school.

High school and college transcripts must be evaluated if earned outside of the U.S. For more information please contact your admissions counselor.

### OFFICIAL TEST SCORES (OPTIONAL)

All test scores must be received directly from the testing agency . Please use the following school codes: SAT / AP / CLEP #6558

### PROOF OF ENGLISH PROFICIENCY

Submit your IELTS or TOEFL test score. (NAU school code 7304) For additional ways to prove English proficiency please contact your admissions counselor.

#### FINANCIAL DOCUMENTS

F-1 or J-1 visa status students must submit a Financial Statement showing evidence of adequate financial support to cover the costs of one full year of study at North American University.
