

GOVERNMENT-ISSUED PHOTO ID

The identification card must not expire before the first day of school.

MEDICAL SHOT RECORD (IF UNDER 22 YEARS OF AGE)

Submit proof of bacterial meningitis vaccination or of an exemption. The vaccination or booster dose must be administered within five years from the first day of the school.

OFFICIAL TEST SCORES (OPTIONAL)

All test scores must be received directly from the testing agency. Please use the following school codes: ACT #4313, SAT/AP/CLEP #6558

OFFICIAL HIGH SCHOOL/ COLLEGE TRANSCRIPTS

All transcripts must be received directly from the issuing institution either by electronic means or in a sealed envelope.
