	The meeting was adjourned at 3:25 PM
	Dr. Smith explained that usually if there is a problem with a student worker, she finds out who the supervisor is and talks to them or contacts the student's department chair. However, Dr. Daudpota's suggestion might be a better option because we don't know who all of the student workers are. Dr. Smith suggested we discuss this further to see if other professors were having issues with student workers.
	Dr. Daudpota suggested that student workers should get forms about behavior and academic progress, similar to athletes.
	Dr. Metts replied that students are warned ahead of time that they will be removed from portal access.
	Dr. Daudpota mentioned that when students are restricted from logging into their portals, they may not know the reason until they talk with technology support.
	Dr. Smith asked if technical support was adequate. Dr. Metts replied that often there isn't someone on call, or students' problems don't get resolved either because the IT workers do not know how to address all of students' issues or because there aren't enough IT workers.
